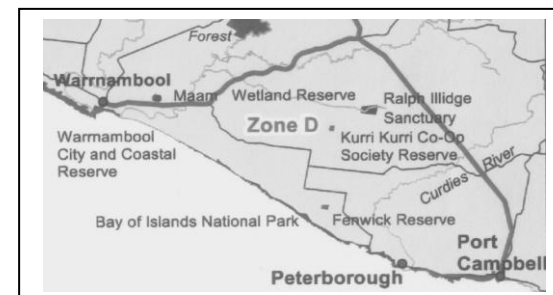

Water: Plants that will grow on water or in areas that are permanently under water.

Lime: Plants that will tolerate limestone soils or soils with a high PH level.

Moist: Grows best in moist, well-drained soils
